- 18 Iowa applicants for the Baldrige Award (2005–2021)
- 2 Iowa applicants in 2019–2021 represent 2,524 jobs, 14 work locations, nearly \$1 billion in revenues/budgets, and more than 200,000 customers served.
- 5 Baldrige examiners from Iowa volunteered more than \$112,000 in services in 2021, and 3 Baldrige • examiners from Iowa volunteered more than \$67,000 in services in 2022.

Baldrige Award Recipient in Iowa

Mary Greeley Medical Center, health care, 2019

Mary Greeley MEDICAL CENTER Opened in 1916 and now the largest independent medical center in its primary and secondary markets, Mary Greeley Medical Center is a public, nonprofit, 220-bed hospital offering inpatient, outpatient, emergency department, home health care, and hospice services. The hospital, which was gifted to the city of Ames by a Union Army officer in the Civil War in memory of his beloved wife, provides health care to the residents of a 14-county area in central lowa. Inpatient and outpatient services support a continuum of care for patients, including surgery, cancer care, cardiac care, diabetes and nutrition care, orthopedics, obstetrics and gynecology, gastroenterology, mental health services, palliative care, home health care, hospice care, rehabilitation, and more.

Highlights

- Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services top decile for 30-day readmissions, 30-day mortality for heart attack • patients, incidence of preventable blood clots, compliance with sepsis practices, influenza vaccinations, stroke bundle compliance, and outpatient imaging measures
- Top-decile inpatient satisfaction since 2016
- More than 75% of inpatients and outpatients recommending the medical center
- Dominant leader in primary market share overall and for inpatient (43%) and outpatient (48%) care since 2015 .

Baldrige-Based Award Programs Serving Iowa

The Alliance for Performance Excellence is a nonprofit national network of Baldrige-based organizations with a mission to grow performance excellence in support of a thriving Baldrige community. Alliance members include Baldrige-based programs that use the Baldrige Excellence Framework to serve organizations from all sectors in their region, state, or a specific industry. These programs annually evaluate and recognize over 1,000 organizations and serve as the feeder system for the national Baldrige Award.

The lowa Quality Center (IQC), an Alliance for Performance Excellence member program, is a customer-focused, highly flexible and innovative organization that is the catalyst to transform individuals and organizations "from good to great to excellent." Formed in 1993, its statewide focus impacts over 100 member organizations with more than 50,000 individuals representing government, manufacturing, business, education, technology, labor, retail, service, and health care organizations throughout the state.

The <u>AHCA/NCAL National Quality Award Program</u>, an Alliance for Performance Excellence member, provides a pathway toward performance excellence for providers of long-term and post-acute care services. The program is based on the core values and criteria of the Baldrige Performance Excellence Program.

Baldrige in the U.S.

- U.S. organizations applying for the Baldrige Award have received 1,791 feedback reports detailing organizational strengths and opportunities for improvement.
- 124 Baldrige Award recipients have shared their role-model practices with other organizations.
- 2010–2021 Baldrige Award applicants represent 687,115 U.S. jobs, 5,086 work sites, more than \$193 billion in revenues/budgets, and about 614 million customers served.
- 103 national Baldrige examiners volunteered roughly \$2.3 million in services in 2022.
- In 2019, 29 independently funded and managed regional, state, and sector Baldrige-based programs evaluated 1,598 organizations using 1,686 volunteer examiners.

The Baldrige Performance Excellence Program

Created with Congressional authorization in 1987, the Baldrige Program helps organizations improve and succeed in the global marketplace. It is the only public-private partnership and Presidential award program dedicated to improving U.S. organizations. In collaboration with the Baldrige community, the Baldrige Program offers a systems approach to organizational excellence, award-winning leadership development, self-assessment tools, organizational assessments by trained experts, workshops on how to improve, and events that showcase best management practices.
